ERASING THE DIGITAL SHADOW NICHOLAS VOLTA

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ABSTRACT

THIS RESEARCH PAPER INVESTIGATES THROUGH MIXED METHODS HOW VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS RESIDING IN THE U.S. CAN ACTIVELY REMOVE PERSONAL DATA FROM ONLINE PLATFORMS TO DEFEND AGAINST CYBER THREATS. THROUGH STATUTORY ANALYSIS, MANUAL OPT-OUTS, AND THIRD-PARTY REMOVAL SERVICES, THIS PAPER IDENTIFIES REALISTIC TACTICS AND LIMITATIONS IN REMOVING THE DIGITAL SHADOW. FOR INSTANCE, KANARY'S REMOVAL TOOL ONLY OPERATES ON IPHONE OPERATION SYSTEM DEVICES. LIKEWISE, MANUAL INPUTS TO REMOVE PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM DATA BROKER WEBSITES CAN RESULT IN RETALIATION BY DATA BROKER WEBSITES INCLUDING PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE AND REPOSTING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION. WHILE FREE TOOLS OFFER PARTIAL COVERAGE, PAID AGENCIES LIKE NORTON REPUTATION DEFENDER PRESENT THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTIONS, PARTICULARLY AGAINST NON-COMPLIANT DATA BROKERS.

CONTEXTUALIZATION

AS SOMEONE WHO HAS INFORMED ON ONE OF THE FBI'S TOP IO MOST WANTED FUGITIVES, ALONG WITH MULTIPLE OTHER FBI FUGITIVES, AND HAS ATTEMPTED SUICIDE BECAUSE OF CYBERHARASSMENT, I AM DEEPLY COMMITTED TO HELPING OUR VULNERABLE PROTECT THEMSELVES, THEIR FRIENDS, AND THEIR FAMILIES ONLINE AND OFFLINE. I UNDERSTAND AND FEEL WHAT IT MEANS TO BE TARGETED, ISOLATED, AND SILENCED—AND I REFUSE TO ALLOW IT TO HAPPEN TO OTHERS.

ONE SUCH VULNERABILITY IS DOXING—MALICIOUS PUBLICATION OF ONE'S CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION ONLINE WITHOUT CONSENT. DOXING CAN HAPPEN THROUGH MULTIPLE METHODS, LIKE PUBLIC RECORD SCRAPING AND DATA BREACHES. ONCE ONE HAS BEEN DOXED—IT CAN ENABLE STALKING, HARASSMENT, IDENTITY THEFT, AND PERMANENT REPUTATIONAL HARM.

Removals

To remove your record please follow these instructions EXACTLY.

(Just FYI, tons of people use to verify their dates are real before meeting in real life. If you use dating apps and remove your record here it looks like a red flag. There's a chance you will get unmatched and blocked.)

AN EXAMPLE OF A DATA BROKER PLATFORM NOT ONLY EXPOSING TENS OF MILLIONS OF AMERICANS' DATA BUT ALSO LEVERAGING SOCIETAL PRESSURE TO DISCOURAGE EFFORTS TO REMOVE IT.

THESIS

THE SIGNIFICANT EXTENT TO WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL RESIDING IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA CAN REMOVE THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE TO AVOID CYBERATTACKS USING PROFESSIONAL RESOURCES AND PROTECT THEMSELVES FROM INDIVIDUALS ATTEMPTING TO PUBLISH SAID PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE. WHILE NOT ALL DATA CAN BE REALISTICALLY SCRUBBED FROM THE INTERNET—A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF INFORMATION CAN.

LEGAL FRAMEWORKS

BEFORE WE CAN EXPLORE METHODS OF REMOVING ONE'S PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE, WE MUST DEFINE AND KNOW THE LEGAL FRAMEWORKS THAT FACILITATE IT. FOR INSTANCE, IN CALIFORNIA, INDIVIDUALS CAN REMOVE THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE WITH THE CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS ACT (REFER TO THE TABLE BELOW FOR COMPREHENSIVE DETAILS). HOWEVER, IF THE PERSON IS NOT IN A STATE THAT HAS THESE PROTECTIONS, THEIR INFORMATION WILL BE MORE DIFFICULT TO REMOVE, AS NOT ALL STATES HAVE THESE ACTS. FOR EASE OF REFERENCE, READERS CAN USE KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS (E.G., CTRL + F) TO LOCATE THEIR STATE WITHIN THE FULL LIST.

A: "THE CTDPA APPLIES TO PEOPLE WHO CONDUCT BUSINESS IN CONNECTICUT OR WHO PRODUCE PRODUCTS OR SERVICES TARGETED TO CONNECTICUT RESIDENTS AND THAT, DURING THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR, CONTROLLED OR PROCESSED THE PERSONAL DATA OF:

- O AT LEAST 100,000 CONSUMERS; OR
- 25,000 OR MORE CONSUMERS AND DERIVED OVER 25% OF GROSS REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF PERSONAL DATA.

HOWEVER, THE CTDPA APPLIES TO ALL CONSUMER HEALTH DATA CONTROLLERS WHO DO BUSINESS IN CONNECTICUT, REGARDLESS OF THEIR SIZE OR THE NATURE OF THEIR DATA PROCESSING ACTIVITIES (SEE BELOW SECTION REGARDING CONSUMER HEALTH DATA CONTROLLERS).

THE CTDPA ALSO APPLIES TO SERVICE PROVIDERS (CALLED "PROCESSORS") THAT MAINTAIN OR PROVIDE SERVICES INVOLVING PERSONAL DATA ON BEHALF OF COVERED BUSINESSES." (6)

- B: "THESE CONTROLLERS AND PROCESSORS MUST: HAVE AN ANNUAL REVENUE OF \$25,000,000 OR MORE AND EITHER CONTROL OR PROCESS PERSONAL DATA OF 100,000 OR MORE CONSUMERS DURING A CALENDAR YEAR, OR DERIVE OVER 50% OF THEIR GROSS REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF PERSONAL DATA AND CONTROL OR PROCESS PERSONAL DATA OF 25,000 OR MORE CONSUMERS" (7)
- C: "THIS CHAPTER APPLIES TO A PERSON CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN THE STATE OR PRODUCING PRODUCTS OR SERVICES THAT ARE TARGETED TO CONSUMERS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF THE STATE AND THAT DURING A CALENDAR YEAR DOES EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - A. CONTROLS OR PROCESSES PERSONAL DATA OF AT LEAST ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND CONSUMERS.
- B. CONTROLS OR PROCESSES PERSONAL DATA OF AT LEAST TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND CONSUMERS AND DERIVES OVER FIFTY PERCENT OF GROSS REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF PERSONAL DATA." (8)



METHODOLOGY

THIS RESEARCH PAPER WILL EMPLOY A MIXED-METHOD APPROACH TO DETERMINE THE EXTENT TO WHICH A PERSON CAN REMOVE THEIR INFORMATION ONLINE. FOR THIS RESEARCH, "PERSONAL INFORMATION" IS DEFINED AS DATA THAT CAN BE LINKED TO AN INDIVIDUAL, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FULL NAME, RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, DATE OF BIRTH, EMAIL ADDRESS, AND BIOMETRIC IDENTIFIERS.

THIS STUDY EXAMINES ONLY DATA THAT IS FREELY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC WITHOUT CIRCUMVENTION OF AUTHENTICATION MEASURES AND STORED INSIDE U.S.-BASED ONLINE PLATFORMS OR DATABASES. INFORMATION EXCLUSIVELY HELD IN PRIVATE IS EXCLUDED FROM THE SCOPE. DUE TO A LACK OF FUNDING, THIS STUDY WILL <u>Not</u> evaluate whether gratis remover agencies work independently and rely on personal testimonies to evaluate the effectiveness of how well they work.

GRATIS REMOVER AGENCIES

WITHIN THE UNITED STATES, MULTIPLE GRATIS REMOVAL AGENCIES EXIST THAT FACILITATE INDIVIDUALS TO DELETE THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE. FOR INSTANCE, GOOGLE ALLOWS A PERSON TO REMOVE THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM SEARCH RESULTS (18), WHICH CAN BE VERY HELPFUL, SINCE INSTEAD OF REMOVING IT FROM DATA BROKERS' WEBSITES THEMSELVES, THEIR PAGE IS REMOVED FROM GOOGLE'S INDEXING. THIS METHOD IS USEFUL IN CASES WHERE AMATEUR CYBERATTACKS USE GOOGLE CHROME FOR THEIR WORK AND ARE UNSURE WHERE TO LOOK FOR THEIR INFORMATION.

LIKEWISE, THIS IS HELPFUL FOR REMOVING GOVERNMENT DATA POINTS (I.E. VOTING RECORDS) FROM GOOGLE'S SEARCH ENGINE INDEX. HOWEVER, THIS METHOD HAS SIGNIFICANT LIMITATIONS. FOR STARTERS, THE SCENARIO APPLIES NARROWLY AND DOESN'T ACCOUNT FOR TARGETED SEARCHES WITHIN DATA BROKER PLATFORMS OR SEARCHES ON ALTERNATE SEARCH ENGINES OR DIRECTLY ON DATA BROKER PLATFORMS, WHICH WOULD RENDER THIS APPROACH INEFFECTIVE.

GIVEN GOOGLE'S LIMITATIONS, ONE MIGHT NEXT CONSIDER MANUALLY OPTING OUT OF DATA BROKER
PLATFORMS DIRECTLY, WHICH MAY WORK. HOWEVER, MANUALLY REMOVING DATA FROM OVER 200 (20) DATA BROKER

WEBSITES IS REALISTICALLY IMPOSSIBLE. THIS ALSO DOES NOT ACCOUNT FOR RETALIATION BY INFAMOUS DATA BROKERS, INCLUDING PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE (REFER TO THE FIRST IMAGE OF THIS PAPER), DELIBERATELY IGNORING TAKEDOWN REQUESTS, AND REPOSTING PERSONAL INFORMATION. THIS WOULD REQUIRE LEGAL TAKEDOWNS, UNDERMINING THE IDEA OF A GRATIS REMOVER AGENCY. (19)

GIVEN THESE CONSTRAINTS, ONE MIGHT THEN CONSIDER AUTOMATED SERVICES AS A MORE VIABLE SOLUTION, INCLUDING KANARY. ALONG WITH AUTOMATICALLY SUBMITTING TAKEDOWN REQUESTS TO DATA BROKERS, IT IS STRAIGHTFORWARD TO COMPLETE, MAKING IT ACCESSIBLE TO A BROAD RANGE OF INDIVIDUALS. HOWEVER, A PARAMOUNT LIMITATION OF THIS SERVICE IS THAT IT CURRENTLY ONLY OPERATES ON IOS DEVICES (2I) AND COVERS A RELATIVELY SMALL SET OF DATA BROKERS, RENDERING IT INEFFECTIVE AGAINST SKILLED CYBERATTACKERS WHO MAINTAIN A COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF BROKER WEBSITES. FURTHERMORE, KANARY DOES NOT ACCOUNT FOR BROKERS THAT DELIBERATELY IGNORE TAKEDOWN REQUESTS, LEAVING A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION POTENTIALLY EXPOSED.

IN SUM, WHILE GOOGLE INDEED OFFERS ONE QUICK AND FREE SOLUTION FOR NARROW SCENARIOS, AND KANARY PROVIDES AUTOMATION FOR A BROAD AUDIENCE YET ONLY FAMOUS DATA BROKERS, NEITHER APPROACH FULLY ADDRESSES THE GRAND SCALE OR PERSISTENCE OF THE THREAT POSED BY DETERMINED CYBERATTACKERS. THIS GAP, DEFINED BY INSUFFICIENT COVERAGE AND RETALIATORY BROKER BEHAVIOR, LEAVES NON-GRATIS REMOVER AGENCIES AS THE ONLY REMAINING PATH TO A PROPER APPROACH TO PERSONAL INFORMATION REMOVAL, WHICH WILL BE EXAMINED IN MY FOLLOWING SECTION.

NON-GRATIS REMOVER AGENCIES

CONTRASTING TO GRATIS REMOVER AGENCIES, NON-GRATIS REMOVER AGENCIES OFFER SERVICES THAT PROVIDE MORE COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTIONS THAT TACKLE THE CHALLENGES THAT FREE TOOLS CANNOT FULLY ADDRESS—INCLUDING DEALING WITH RETALIATORY DATA BROKERS AND COVERING A BROADER RANGE OF PLATFORMS. AS THERE ARE MULTIPLE PAID COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTIONS AVAILABLE, WE WILL FOCUS ON ONE OBJECTIVE "BEST" OPTION BASED ON SIX CANDIDATES. REFER TO THE TABLE BELOW FOR ALL CANDIDATES AND THE CRITERIA USED TO EVALUATE WHICH IS "BEST."

IN SUM, OBJECTIVELY FROM THE TABLE, NORTON'S REPUTATION DEFENDER IS OBJECTIVELY THE "BEST." INDEED, WHILE IT REQUIRES A CONSULTATION, IT IS EASY TO USE, COVERS MANY DATA BROKERS, WORKS AGAINST RETALIATORY COMPANIES, AND OFFERS ADDITIONAL SERVICES BASED ON THE PURCHASED TIER.

CONCLUSION

THE EXTENT TO WHICH A VULNERABLE INDIVIDUAL CAN REMOVE THEIR INFORMATION ONLINE IS CONTINGENT ON THE RESOURCES THEY USE; MULTIPLE GRATIS AGENCIES EXIST; HOWEVER, THEY ARE LIMITED AND RISK BEING SUBJECT TO RETALIATION BY DATA BROKER AGENCIES VIA THE REPOSTING OF THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION. ON THE OTHER HAND, NON-GRATIS AGENCIES ARE MORE THOROUGH AND OFFER MORE COMPREHENSIVE FEATURES. FOR EXAMPLE, NORTON'S REPUTATION DEFENDER OFFERS ONE ON ONE COUNSELING CONCERNING THEIR INFORMATION.
